

Merrick County Board Minutes



March 10, 2015

The Merrick County Board of Supervisors met Tuesday, March 10, 2015 at 9:08 a.m. in the Supervisors Room, County Courthouse, Central City, NE, with Graves, Kucera, Carlson, Weller, Kreachbaum, Helgoth, and Wiegert present. Also present was County Attorney Lynelle Homolka.

Moved Kucera, second Graves to convene as Board of Supervisors at 9:08 a.m. Roll Call: All Ayes

Notice of the meeting was given thereof by publications in the Republican Nonpareil and The Palmer Journal and on the Merrick County website. Proof of publication is filed in the Clerk's Office. Copies of the agenda were mailed to each Supervisor and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

Chairman Wiegert declared the meeting was preceded by publicized notice and having acknowledged and identified the location of the posting of the current copy of the Open Meetings Act, called the meeting to order and in open session at 9:08 a.m.

Agenda: Moved Kucera, second Carlson to approve the agenda as presented. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Minutes: Moved Kreachbaum, second Weller to approve the minutes from the February 24, 2015 as presented and published. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Meeting reports: Carlson & Weller met with Veteran Service Officer Berry and went over his duties and what was going on in his office; Graves attended a hospital meeting on February 25, 2015; Weller attended the Development Corporation meeting Friday, March 6, 2015; Kreachbaum attended an emergency management meeting with Boone, and Nance Counties on March 4, 2015 and reported that if anyone wanted to join there will be a meeting March 12, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. at the Community Room; Wiegert attended a Central District Health meeting on February 27 and another one March 9, 2015 and also attended the Midland Area on Aging meeting on March 5, 2015.

Official's report: County Attorney Homolka, Chief Deputy Westman, and Sheriff Campbell attended a three day child abuse conference. Veteran Service Officer Berry thanked Carlson and Weller for coming and meeting with him and also the Veteran Service Board. Sheriff Campbell said the deputies had 348 calls for service and there were 75 contacts by deputies. Deputies had 119 hours of patrol time, covered 12 accidents, 5 were weather related, 8 HHS calls where one was for verbal disturbance, one physical disturbance, and one aggravated assault report, 65 civil process served and returned, did six prisoner transports, three fraud cases were reported, five burglary or theft cases were reported, five arrests, four were misdemeanor's and one was a felony. Dispatch had 500 total calls for service, handled 18 medical recues, three fire calls, transferred five 911 calls to other counties, handled 32 vins for the month, 17 gun permits, had 20 new inmates booked in and released 19. They had an average of 8 inmates for the month and served approximately 672 meals.

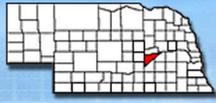
Hospital update: Litzenberg Hospital Administrator Julie Murray gave the Board a brief overview and handout.

Merrick Manor: Hospital Administrator Murray told the Board that the hospital had received a bid of \$25,000.00 from Mesner's for the Merrick Manor. Murray said that the size and square footage of the building has held other investors off. Mesner's told the hospital board that they would pay \$25,000.00 for the Merrick Manor is the Development Corporation would help with the asbestos removal. The Development Corporation will pay \$70,000.00 towards the asbestos removal. Mesner's are looking at commercial space on the first two floors and apartments on the third floor. The hospital cannot accept the bid without the approval from the County Board. The hospital board did approve of the bid and bringing the bid to the County Board in open session and it is in their minutes. Moved Kucera, second Graves to approve the hospital board accepting the \$25,000.00 bid from Mesner's for the Merrick Manor. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Juvenile Diversion Interlocal with Hamilton County: Juvenile Diversion Officer Julie Beyer asked the Board for their approval of an Interlocal Cooperative Agreement for Juvenile Diversion by and between the Counties of Merrick and Hamilton. The Hamilton County Commissioners approve of the agreement at their February 23, 2015 meeting. This agreement will be good through January 30, 2016. The grant money will be in the amount of \$13,500.00 and will be used to increase Beyer's salary, her travel, a bigger data plan, education and materials because of additional duties. Moved Kreachbaum, second Carlson to approve and have the Chairman sign the Juvenile Diversion Interlocal with Hamilton County. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Special liquor license: Harley Conway, DBA Bootlegger, Inc. asked for the Board's approval of a special liquor license for a wedding reception on Saturday, April 11, 2015 at the Randy Wegner farm. Randy Wegner's son is getting married. Moved Kucera, second Kreachbaum to approve the special liquor license for the Bootlegger, Inc. for the wedding reception on Saturday, April 11, 2015 at the Randy Wegner farm. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Public Hearing: Moved Weller, second Kreachbaum to open the public hearing at 10:00 a.m. for a re-zoning application for Cedar Lane II Subdivision Association in 12-13-6. Roll Call: All Ayes. Planning & Zoning Myers said this Subdivision was done last year and it was thought that the zoning was already done. It is zoned as AG-1 and needs to be zoned as R-1. The R-1 has shorter setbacks for building requirements. Moved Graves, second Carlson to close the

hearing at 10:04 a.m. Roll Call: All Ayes. Moved Graves, second Carlson to approve the rezoning application for Cedar Lane II Subdivision Association in 12-13-6 to change from AG-1 to R-1. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Subdivision application: Planning & Zoning Myers presented a Subdivision Application for Rick Wegner in the SE1/4 in 8-13-7. This split was previously approved but nothing was done with the property within the one year requirement. Moved Graves, second Kreachbaum to approve the subdivision application for Rick Wegner in the SE1/4 of 8-13-7. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Subdivision application: Planning & Zoning Myers presented a Subdivision Application for Curt and Doreen Fenster in the NW1/4 14-12-8. There was a previous split in this quarter with over 23 acres. After this split the remaining parcel will have 20.01 acres left and there will be no other splits allowed in this quarter. Moved Kreachbaum, second Graves to approve the Subdivision Application for Curt and Doreen Fenster in the NW1/4 14-12-8. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Brite Express: Brite Express would like to hire Henry Sobotka as a part time person to help them clean when needed. Moved Kucera, second Graves to go into executive session at 10:32 a.m. for the prevention of needless injury to the reputation of an individual. Roll Call: All Ayes. Moved Helgoth, second Kucera to go out of executive session at 10:41 a.m. Roll Call: All Ayes. Moved Helgoth, second Weller to approve of Brite Express hiring Henry Sobotka as a part time person to help them clean when needed. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Carpet cleaning: Brite Express presented a bid to clean the carpets in the hearing room, entrance pad on first floor, Board Room, main court room, Diversion Office, and the Probation Office. The bid was for \$1,163.10. Moved Graves, second Carlson to approve the bid for \$1,163.00 presented by Brite Express to clean the carpets in the hearing room, entrance pad on first floor, Board Room, main court room, Diversion Office, and the Probation Office. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Maintainer/motor grader training: Highway Superintendent Meyer presented a letter that needed the Board's approval for the Chairman to sign for maintainer/motor grader training. There is no cost to the county and is done by LTAP. It is a two day training. Moved Kucera, second Weller to approve the Chairman signing the letter from LTAP for a two day training for maintainer/motor graders. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Easement: Highway Superintendent Meyer informed the County Board about a driveway easement for Keystone for their pipe yard in Section 3 right off of 23rd Road.

Agreement for the Merrick County Youth and Agriculture Education Center: Education Educator Tammy Stuhr presented the Agreement of Merrick County Board of Supervisors, Merrick County Agricultural Society, and the Merrick County Extension Board for the Merrick County Youth and Agriculture Education Center for the County Board's approval. The Extension Board approved the agreement at their March 3, 2015 meeting and it will go to the Agricultural Society on March 19, 2015 for their approval. Moved Helgoth, second Graves to approve and have the Chairman sign the Agreement of Merrick County Board of Supervisors, Merrick County Agricultural Society, and the Merrick County Extension Board for the Merrick County Youth and Agriculture Education Center. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Trunk line: Sheriff Campbell asked for the Board's approval of \$5,600.00 to be paid to Century Link to move two trunk lines to Grand Island. Currently if the Sheriff's Office would need to be evacuated or would be hit by a tornado, etc. no calls would come in or out for 911. By moving the trunk lines to Grand Island if a something should happen to the Sheriff's Office, 911 calls would be transferred to Nance County. Hall County wanted to charge Merrick County if 911 calls were to be transferred there. Nance, Boone and Merrick County will work together because Platte County wanted to charge for calls to be transferred there also. Nance County will not charge Merrick County and it will work the other way also it 911 calls have to be transferred. It would work like a computer relay. Some of the funds for this would come out of the Wireless E911 funds which the county receives. Moved Kucera, second Kreachbaum to approve the \$5,600.00 to Century Link for trunk line moving for the new E911 system to Grand Island. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Time and attendance: The Sheriff's Office is the only office at present time that are being paid for actual hours worked. MIPS said that they could install and train for just one department for the new time and attendance and then install the rest at the end of the year. The time machines are about \$650.00 a piece. The employees would clock in by finger print. Those that start work on the road from home will have a call in system. Clerk Wichmann passed out a request for leave or approved absence sheet that will be required to be turned into her office when employees will not be attendance ahead of time so that their time can be entered if they have earned time off in her office. Moved Kreachbaum, second Weller to approve the County Clerk ordering the time and attendance machine for the Sheriff's Office. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Safety Deposit Box: The Treasurer keeps a safety deposit box at Cornerstone Bank for tapes that they back up from the State's AS400. The Treasurer needs to add her Deputy Treasurer Angela Kosmicki to the safety deposit box. Moved Graves, second Kreachbaum to approve the Treasurer adding her Deputy Treasurer Angela Kosmicki to the County safe deposit box at the Cornerstone Bank.
