The Merrick County Board of Equalization met Tuesday, January 28, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. in the Supervisors Room, County Courthouse, Central City, NE, with Graves, Helgoth, Kucera, Hahn, Jefferson, Weller, and Wiegert present. County Attorney Homolka was also present.
